



## \$5,000 SCHOLARSHIP

**Background:** The Sonoma County Women-In-Law Scholarship was established in 2001. The Scholarship is funded by donations from private individuals and law firms in Sonoma County.

**Purpose:** The purpose of the scholarship is to assist a deserving law student with an interest in promoting women's access to, and involvement in, the legal system to complete their legal education by defraying some of the costs.

**Qualifications:**

- Ties to Sonoma County
- Completion of a minimum of one year of law school
- A record of academic achievement
- Demonstrated commitment to increasing women's access to legal services, and/or involvement in, the practice of law

**Details:**

This year (2009), Sonoma County Women in Law will be awarding a \$5000 scholarship to one student currently registered at a Northern California law school who meets the qualifications listed above.

The Scholarship Committee will be comprised of three members of the Women-In-Law Board of Directors. Students of both genders and all backgrounds are encouraged to apply. The deadline to apply is November 1, 2008.
