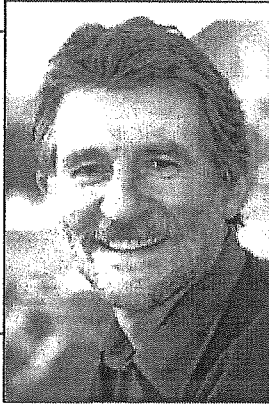

Desmond McNeill graduated in economics from the University of Cambridge in 1969, and received his Ph.D in economics at University of London in 1988.

He has been a Lecturer at both University College London and University of Edinburgh. After moving to Norway he worked as a consultant and later adviser to NORAD. He was Director of the Centre for Development and the Environment, University of Oslo, Norway and is now a Senior Researcher at the Center. Mr. McNeill is visiting a visiting scholar at UC Berkeley.

He has researched and published on a wide range of topics, including foreign aid policy, sustainable development, consumption patterns, water, interdisciplinary research, and the relationship between research and policy. He has worked as adviser or consultant for various aid agencies including World Bank, UNDP, NORAD, ODA, USAID, Asian Development Bank. He has worked in more than 15 developing countries, including Sri Lanka, Tanzania, Indonesia, Egypt, Mali, Nepal and Ecuador.
