Professor Williams has written extensively in state constitutional law and legislation, including casebooks in those areas and a book on New Jersey Constitutional Law. He also co-produced a television documentary marking the fiftieth anniversary of the New Jersey Constitution. He has been active as counsel in many public interest cases. Professor Williams received his B.A. cum laude from Florida State University, his J.D. with honors from the University of Florida, where he was Executive Editor of the Law Review and a member of the Order of the Coif, and LL.M. degrees from New York University (1970) and Columbia University (1980). He teaches Civil Procedure, Legislation, State Constitutional Law, and New Jersey Constitutional Law.
