

Certificate of Specialization in Energy and Clean Technology Law (LLM)

Requirements for the 2010-2011 Academic Year

Students must fulfill at least **16 units** from the courses listed below. Students are encouraged to take a balanced load of courses and must take **at least one course from each category**. Course units are indicated in parentheses.

Students may complete their LLM Capstone Writing Project on a topic related to energy or clean technology law through one of the courses listed below that requires a 15-20 page paper, or through independent study (299), which units will count toward the 16 unit requirement. LLM students seeking to satisfy their Capstone requirement through this certificate must submit the Course Substitution Request Form (located on the LLM bSpace site) to the Registrar by the end of the first week of classes.
