(2002-2004 Average)¹⁴

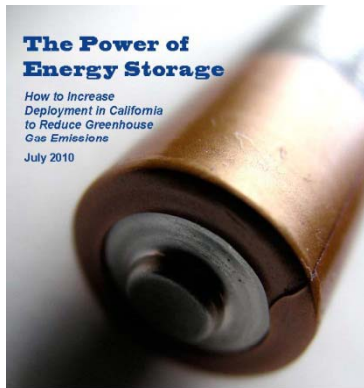

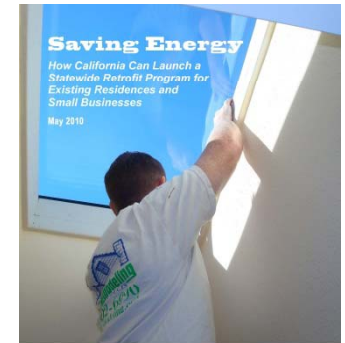

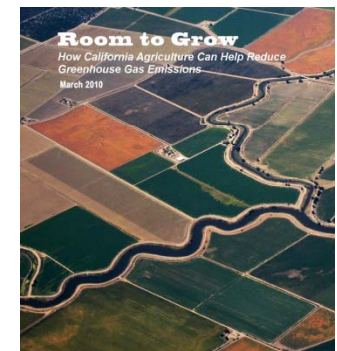
