Frank (D-MA)	Creates a Consumer Financial Protection Agency, a Financial Stability Council, ends public bailouts, reforms executive compensation, establishes central clearing for derivatives, strengthens regulation of securities markets, outlaws predatory lending, and requires registration of hedge funds	Signed by the President	2-Dec-09
H.R. 3126	Consumer Financial Protection Agency	Rep. Barney Frank (D-MA)	Establishes Consumer Protection Financial Agency	Dead (Reported by committee)	8-Jul-09
H.R. 1456	Consumer Overdraft Protection Fair Practices Act	Rep. Maloney (D-NY)	Extends protections of Truth in Lending Act to overdraft protection programs of depository institutions	Dead (Referred to committee)	12-Mar-09
H.R. 2309	Consumer Credit and Debt Protection Act	Rep. Rush (D-IL)	Provides authority to FTC to expedite credit or debt rulemaking	Dead (Referred to committee)	7-May-09
H.R. 2327	Protection of Consumer Credit and Consumer Choice Act of 2009	Rep. Hensarling (R-TX)	Protects consumer choices and access to credit and improves consumer disclosure	Dead (Referred to committee)	7-May-09
H.R. 3310	Consumer Protection and Regulatory Enhancement Act	Rep. Bachus (R-AL)	Improves consumer protections and addresses other regulatory concerns	Dead (Referred to committee)	23-Jul-09
