

The authorities for this request are Penal Code Sections 1054--1054.7, and Meeks v. Superior Court (1991) 230 CA3d 698.

Compliance with this request must be made within 15 days from your receipt of this request (Penal Code Section 1054.5(b)), or a motion for sanctions may be filed with the Court.

Suspect Status: In custody Santa Rita Jail Summary: Elderts gets into an argument with Lewis then shoots Lewis in the leg with an AK-47 assault rifle.

Narrative: On 5-19-95 about 2100 hours I received a call of a shooting at 2254 Lobert St. While en route I was told that the roommate, Paul, shot the (v) and the roommate was in his room. The weapon was a rifle and the (v), Mark Lewis, is in the front door way. The (s) is now in the living room, he is Hawaiian about 5'11", thin build, wearing a Federal Express uniform.

I arrived along with several other units and saw the (v), Mark Lewis, laying on the floor at the front door entry way, inside the house, bleeding from a gunshot wound to his leg area.

The (s), Paul Elderts, who was Hawaiian, about 5'11", tall, thin build, wearing a blue Federal Express uniform was arrested in the front room area.

Paramedics and Alameda County Fire Personnel treated Lewis for a gun shot wound to his right thigh area. About 2118 hours, Lewis was transported to Eden Hospital for further medical treatment. (See supplement by deputy D. Nelson)

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When Elderts was arrested and taken out of the house he told me the rifle was in his bedroom on top of his bed.

The crime scene was contained and a consent to search was signed by Elderts and Anne Johnson, Lewis' live-in girlfriend. (See attached)

A gun shot residue test was performed on Elderts by Deputy Powell before he was transported to ETS by Deputy Godlewski.

I met with Anne Johnson who said she and her 13 year old son have been living with Lewis at 2254 Lobert St. for about 3 months. Elderts rents a room from Lewis and has been living at 2254 Lobert St. for about 3 weeks.

Johnson said at about 2100 hours, Elders came home and an argument started between Lewis and Elderts over the use of the washing machine and dryer. Elderts went to his bedroom and Lewis followed. Elderts and Lewis pushed each other in the entry way of Paul's bedroom. After the argument, Lewis came back into the front room area, when she heard someone say "a gun". Lewis pushed away from him when she saw Elderts standing in the

front room next to the entryway to the hallway. Elderts had a rifle in his hands, then shot Lewis. Johnson took her son to the bedroom and called the police. (See statement)

Johnson's son, Bryan Johnson, also related the same story. (See statement)

EVIDENCE: I performed a gun shot residue test on Anne Johnson and Deputy Miles performed a gun shot residue test on Bryan Johnson. Deputy Miles gave me his gun shot residue test and I put both tests into evidence at ETS.

I took the clothing Elderts was wearing and placed them into evidence at ETS.

SCENE: I saw an AK-47 assault rifle laying on a rifle case that was opened on top of the bed in the south bedroom. Johnson said this bedroom was Elderts'. The bedroom at the southeast end of the house contained numerous free weights for weightlifting. The other bedroom was used by Lewis and Johnson. The house is a three bedroom, two bath, single family home. For further see tech report by Deputy Powell.

Suspect Record: Elderts is not known to corpus.

Victim Statement: On 5-20-95 about 1710 hours, I met with Mark Lewis at the ICU unit at Eden Hospital. Lewis said that Paul came home on 5-19-95 about 2100 hours and an argument started over Elderts being disrespectful to him and his house. Elderts went to his bedroom and Lewis confronted him, poking Elderts chest with his finger three times. Lewis started to leave and Elderts slammed his bedroom door. Lewis went back to Elderts door, opened it, and saw Elderts trying to pour bullets from a box into a rifle. Lewis shoved Elderts causing him to fall against his tv. Elderts got up with the rifle in his hands, then pushed Lewis out of his way using the rifle. Elderts walked toward the front door and Lewis went after him. Elderts leveled the rifle pointing the barrel at Lewis' face. Eldert had his finger on the trigger. Lewis grabbed the barrel with both hands and pointed the barrel downwards. Eldert pulled the trigger, shooting Lewis in the right leg. Lewis said he wishes to press charges. (See statement)

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Suspect Statement: On 5-20-95 about 1830 hours I recontacted Elderts at Santa Rita Jail to give him another chance to tell his side of the story since Elderts wished to remain silent on 5-19-95 about 2400 hours.

Elderts said he has been living at 2254 Lobert St. since 5-01-95. Elderts has known Lewis for about 4-5 years. Elderts said on 5-19-95 about 2100 hours he came home and Lewis and Johnson started arguing with him over the use of the washer and dryer. Elerts went into his bedroom and Lewis confronted him in his bedroom. Lewis confronts Elderts several times, then starts punching Elderts in the face and neck as Elderts tries to go to the front door with his AK-47 assault rifle. Elderts points the AK-47 rifle at Lewis' right leg. Elderts shot Lewis to get him off of him and to get out of the house. (See statement)

Elderts complained the left side of his jaw was still sore. When I talked to Elderts on 5-19-95 about 2400 hours the left side of his neck was red. No other visible injuries were seen.

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On 5-20-95 about 2010 hours I requested and received a urine sample from Elderts while at Santa Rita. The urine sample was packaged and sent to a lab to be analyzed. Since I believe Elderts was under the influence of methamphetamine. When I interviewed him on 5-19-95 about 2400 hours while at ETS.

While I was talking to Elderts on 5-19-95 about 2400 hours I saw his pupils to be very large almost to the rim in the controlled lighting in the holding cell. Elderts speech was fast and loud and he could not stop talking. Elderts could not stand still while sitting in his chair. Elderts movements were rapid and he swung his arms around as he spoke. I did not smell any odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his person.

No other symptoms were observed or tests performed.

Paul Elderts has been renting a room from me for the past three weeks at 2254 Lobert St. I have known Elderts for about 11/2 years since I rented a room from him about 11/2 years ago. Anne Johnson is my live-in girlfriend. I have been dating Johnson for about 13/4 years.

On 5-19-95 about 2100 hours I was watching to with Anne Johnson and her 13 year old son, Bryan Johnson, when Elderts came home. I talked to Elderts about being disrespectful to me and my house. I was also upset at Elderts for throwing my girlfriends clothes on the floor or on top of the dryer. Elderts said he also lives here and he is going to do things the way he wants to. Elderts then went to his bedroom and I followed him. I confronted Elderts about 2 ft into his bedroom and poked Elderts chest with my right index finger only once. Elderts told me not to touch him so I poked his chest again. Elderts told me again not to touch him and I poked Eldert's chest a third time. I turned around and walked out of Elderts bedroom. Elderts slammed the bedroom door which upset me more. I went back to

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Elderts bedroom door and opened the door. I saw Elderts trying to pour bullets from a box into a rifle. I then shoved Elderts real hard causing him to lose his balance and fall against the tv. Elderts got up and had the rifle still in his hands. Elderts pushed me by putting the rifle sideways against my chest. Elderts pushed me out of his way and then walked towards the front door. I went after Elderts when Elderts put the butt of the rifle on his shoulder and leveled it at me pointing the barrel at my face. The barrel was about 2-3 feet away from my face. I grabbed the barrel with both hands and pointed it downwards. Elderts then pulled the trigger and shot me in my right leg. I went down and told Anne and Bryan to go to my bedroom and call 911. I also told them not to come out of the bedroom.

When Elderts leveled the rifle at me, pointing the barrel at my face, he had his finger on the trigger. I wish to press charges against Elderts.

I only know Elderts by his first name "Paul"

Lewis started telling me that I could not use the washer and dryer since Johnson had told Lewis that I was not using the washer and dryer right. Lewis and Johnson kept yelling and screaming at me.

Lewis backed me into my bedroom and I told Lewis not to touch me several times and to leave me alone. Lewis pushed me again three more times with his right hand hitting my shoulder. Lewis then said "I touched you three times so what are you going to do about that." Johnson and her son were still in the front room watching tv. Lewis then started to walk away when I tried to close my bedroom door. Lewis saw that I was trying to close my bedroom door when Lewis slammed open my bedroom door. My gun case which contained the AK-47 assault rifle was standing up behind my bedroom door. Lewis walked away and I closed my bedroom door. I grabbed my McDonalds orange drink and car keys, opened my bedroom door and started to walk towards the front door. Lewis charged me again and started pushing and swinging his fists at me. I dropped my drink in the hallway area. I was trying to block Lewis' punches and hands.

Lewis then turned around and started to walk back to his chair. I ran to my room and tried to close my bedroom door. Lewis came to my bedroom door and kept pushing on the door, trying to get inside my bedroom. I couldn't lock my bedroom door, so I grabbed my AK-47 rifle from the black case that was next to my bedroom door. The rifle was not loaded. Lewis stopped pushing on my bedroom door, so I put a 4" clip, containing several bullets, into the rifle. All I was thinking about was getting to the front door. Lewis started pounding on my bedroom door again, forcing my bedroom door open. Lewis came into my bedroom, lost his balance, hitting the TV. Lewis grabbed the left side of my sweatshirt as I started to run out of the bedroom. I kept the rifle in my right hand. I started to run towards the front door, dragging Lewis as he was pounding on the left side of my face and neck with a closed fist. I dragged Lewis all the way to the front door, where I got caught between the footrest, chair and front door. I got the front door open, but Lewis kept holding me in, continuing to punch me. I lowered my rifle and aimed for Lewis' leg. Johnson had gotten up and was walking towards me. I fired one shot at Lewis, hitting his right leg. I shot Lewis to get him off of me and to get out of the house.

I went to my room and put the rifle and case on top of my bed. The police arrived and arrested me in the front room. When I was escorted outside, I told Deputy Lind that the rifle was on top of my bed. This statement is given freely and voluntarily.

My left side of my jaw is very sore and the left side of neck was red on 5/19/95 about 2300 hours. My sweatshirt collar was torn and the hand pocket was ripped during this incident.

Deputy Lind requested a urine sample on 5-20-95 about 2005 hours, since he believed I was under the influence of methamphetamine. I freely and voluntarily gave him a urine sample.

On Friday, 05-19-95, about 2100 hours, I responded, as a cover unit, to the control of the contr

was in front of the residence when Deputy GODLEWSKI brought ELDERTS out to is car. Sergeant HART requested that I conduct a Gunshot Residue Collection Kit on ELDERTS' hands. I explained to ELDERTS that I was forming this as the evidence collection process. ELDERTS told me: "You lon't have to do that. I did it, I shot him." I then conducted the Gunshot Residue Collection Kit on both of ELDERTS hands.

Deputy J. LIND, who was the primary officer on the scene, requested I take control of the crime scene and conduct Field Evidence Technician duties. Deputy LIND advised me that he had a consent to search the residence from one JOHNSON, a resident and domestic partner of the victim. Deputy LIND showed me that there was an assault rifle, which is the suspected weapon involved in this incident, laying on the bed in the east bedroom of the residence. I asked Anne JOHNSON who this room was occupied by. JOHNSON cold me that she rented the room to Paul ELDERTS, the suspect.

Deputy GODLEWSKI was transporting ELDERTS to ETS. I contacted Deputy GODLEWSKI, via the radio, and advised him that I needed consent, from LDERTS, to search ELDERTS room. Deputy GODLEWSKI advised that ELDERTS gave erbal consent. Deputy GODLEWSKI advised that he would obtain a written consent to search from ELDERTS when they arrived at ETS. (See supplemental eport by Deputy GODLEWSKI.)

RIME SCENE:

Castro Valley, is a single level, three bedroom, two athroom, single family dwelling with a family room and a kitchen and an ttached single car garage. The residence has a stucco finish on the utside and sheetrock inside. The residence is located on the north side of obert Street. Lobert street runs east and west. There is a single family esidence on the east and the west sides of the residence. Highway 580 is ocated to the rear/north of the residence with a barrier wall between the esidence and the highway. The front door faces south, towards Lobert treet.

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The master bedroom is located on the north-east corner of the house and has a bath room in the south-east corner of the bedroom. There is a bedroom on the center east side of the residence; JOHNSON told me this is the room she rents to ELDERTS. There is a bathroom west of the east bedroom. The third bedroom is located on the south-east corner of the house and is a spare bedroom with a bed and weight lifting equipment.

The Kitchen is located on the north-west corner of the residence and the garage is located on the south-west corner of the residence.

The living room, or family room, is located in the center of the residence with the front door on the south wall, facing Lobert Street. Just inside the front door was a pile of clothes. The clothes were saturated with a red wet substance, presumably the victims blood. The carpet in this area was saturated with a red wet substance. About one foot north-east of the door was an expended bullet casing. In the north-east corner, of the living room, was a live bullet casing.

The east bedroom, the bathroom west of the east bedroom, the south-east bedroom, and the living room are joined by a sub-hallway. On the floor, in the middle of this hallway, was a crushed McDonald's drink cup. There were ice-cubes on the floor and in the drink cup. The door to the east bedroom, leading from the hallway, was splattered with an amber color liquid. This liquid was also splattered over the weapon on the bed, the dresser on the vest wall inside the east bedroom, and a speaker on the north-west wall of the east bedroom. From the splatters, which were still wet, it appeared that the drink had been thrown against the open bedroom door and spread throughout the room. The wet splatters on the rifle would be consistent with the weapon case being open, and on the bed, when the drink was thrown against the door.

t appeared that there had been a struggle in the east Bedroom. The T.V. and VCR, which are located on the south wall of the room, had apparently een sitting on a pair of large speakers. The T.V. and VCR were knocked wer and laying on the floor next to the foot of the bed. The VCR was on the T.V. was off. There was a crushed Mcdonald's bag on the floor in he north-west corner. This bag contained french fries.

VIDENCE:

- tem # 1: Expended bullet casing. PMC, 7.62 X 39mm, from just inside the front door, on the floor. The casing has red streaks, possibly blood, on the outside.
- tem # 2: Live bullet. PMC, 7.62 X 39mm, from floor next to speaker in north-east corner of living room.

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- Item # 3: Assault Rifle: KBI INC., Model SA85M, Serial #SM07839, Caliber 7.62 X 39mm. (Similar to an AK-47) The rifle was laying in an open case, in plain sight, on the bed in the east bedroom. There was a magazine in the weapon and the bolt was closed. When I removed the magazine there were three live PMC 7.62 X 39mm rounds in it. When I opened the bolt there was one live PMC 7.62 X 39mm round in the chamber. Gloves were worn while handling the weapon.
- Item # 4: 7.62 X 39mm ammunition magazine. Magazine appears to hold six
 rounds. Collected from item # 3.
- Item # 5: Three live bullets. PMC, 7.62 X 39mm, from magazine listed in
 item #4.
- Ttem # 6: One live bullet. PMC, 7.62 X 39mm, recovered from chamber of item #3.
- Item # 7: Hoppes Protecto Rifle case. Recovered from bed in east bedroom.
- Item # 8: One live round. PMC 7.62 X 39mm. Bullet was laying next to
 rifle in case, on bed in east bedroom.
- Item # 9: Gunshot Residue Collection Kit. Conducted on suspect ELDERTS'
 hands.
- Item #10: Receipt. This receipt was located in the rifle case, on the bed in the east bedroom. The receipt shows the above listed rifle (Item #3), was purchased from Traders Sports INC., San Leandro, on 05-09-94, by Paul Hiapumalulaui ELDERTS. A photo-copy of the receipt is attached to this report. Sheriff's Radio was unable to locate a dealers report of sale, or registration, on the weapon.
- Item #11: Kodak 35mm film. I took photos of the crime scene and all items of evidence. The film was placed into evidence for processing.
- Item #12: Clothes. One green tee shirt, one pair of shorts, one pair of bikini underwear. These items were saturated with apparent blood and located inside the front doorway, on the floor, of the residence. The clothes were cut off the victim, by the medical personnel, and I could not locate any bullet holes in the clothes. Because the clothes were saturated with apparent blood, they were hung up in the over-night evidence room to dry.

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Item #13: Two ammunition magazines. 7.62 X 39mm, ninety round magazines. These magazines appear to fit the rifle listed in #3. The magazines were empty. They were located inside a brown bag in the closet in the east bedroom.

All items were handled with gloves, to preserve any evidence that may later be recovered by the laboratory. All items of evidence were packaged and placed into evidence, at ETS, by me.

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
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
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
