Asymmetric information offers great challenges to settlements, creating an uneven balance of information that can negatively effect the outcome of a case in a number of ways. Despite this, there may be way to bypass the hurdles caused by asymmetric information: judgement contingent clauses. Visiting scholar [Avraham Tabbach](#) will present his work on these such clauses, a method of equalizing the outcome of the settlement regardless of the information imbalance, and how judgement contingent clauses can help overcome any other obstacles asymmetric information can create.
