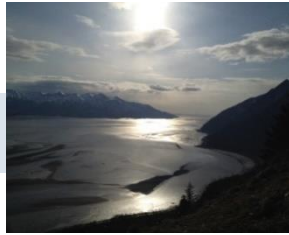


Exploring Careers with Environmental NGOs
