Good afternoon Stephanie Campos-Bui,

In an effort to protect the public and staff during the COVID-19 pandemic, Lake County Superior Court has extended all traffic pay or appear dates and payment dates that were originally scheduled from March 18, 2020 through May 31, 2020 out to June 2020 and later. Additionally, the court has not sent any unpaid fines or fees for collection since March 1, 2020 and no civil assessments have been assessed. When payments are not made on established payment plans, due dates are being extended out and no late fees are being assessed. Further extensions could occur depending on when the public health emergency ends.

All juvenile billings and collections for at least the period of this pandemic have been suspended and will likely stay suspended until SB1290 decides the collection of past fines and fees.
