APPLICATION FOR RE-ENROLLMENT- LL.M. EXECUTIVE TRACK- OPTION A STUDENTS

- Students must submit this form to the Law School Registrar’s Office, 270 Simon Hall by email at registrar@law.berkeley.edu or by fax (510) 642-2277.
- Applications for Spring re-enrollment are due on November 1 of the year before you wish to return, applications for Summer re-enrollment are due January 15 of the year in which you wish to return, and applications for Fall are due on June 1 of the year in which you wish to return. If you submit your application later than this date, you may miss the initial enrollment period and therefore have less priority for your preferred courses. The LL.M. executive track- option A program is comprised of three consecutive semesters: one spring, one summer, and one fall. Therefore, a student who withdraws from spring is only eligible to return the following spring. A student who withdraws before completing their summer semester is only eligible to return the following summer. A student who withdraws from fall is only eligible to return the following fall.
- Students who fail a degree requirement course must re-take the course in order to graduate. As such, they must re-enroll for the next term in which that course is offered and must pay the tuition for that entire term. Please be aware that some degree requirement courses are only offered once a year, which means students must come back the following year to re-take the course they failed.
- Please note that re-enrollment for students on withdrawal status is subject to Law School approval and is not guaranteed, except for students on parental leave. Re-enrollment from a medical withdrawal may need additional approval from University Health Services.
