Brian Nguyen is a student at the UC Berkeley Graduate School of Journalism. Prior to this, he worked in the news industry as a visual journalist for newspapers, such as the Chicago Tribune, and on media innovation for major publishing companies. His work focuses on gun violence, policing, and inequality.

For the Miller Fellowship, Brian will be working with the Human Rights Center's Executive Director Alexa Koenig in the interdisciplinary Human Rights Center Investigations Lab. The lab conducts research on war crimes and other violations of human rights through discovery, verification, and analysis of information—and potential evidence—found online. The lab consists of some 50 students, both graduate and undergraduate who come from multiple departments on campus to work on timely research and investigations with legal organizations, global NGOs, and media. Brian brings expertise as a reporter to open source investigation projects related to international criminal law, advocacy, and journalism. He will assist with open source investigative projects as well as teaching and training.
