Good morning folks - I've attached a draft memo for your review regarding a new TRULINCS feature. The new feature allows the filtering out of specifically identified emails when conducting a search of a specific inmate's email activity. This feature was developed as a result of concern raised by some judges regarding the fact we do not offer confidential attorney-client email communication. In lieu of having to have an entirely separate email system for inmates to write their attorneys, we decided to offer this feature instead. This feature would ordinarily come into play when a criminal AUSA or law enforcement has asked us for all of the pre-trial inmate's emails. Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns.
