

USPTO's Prioritized Patent Examination Program

Need to FAST track your patent? Use Track One!

Effective September 24, 2021, the limit on the number of prioritized examination requests that may be accepted in a fiscal year is increased from 12,000 to 15,000.

Fast innovation is America's competitive edge. If you need to move your ideas quickly, USPTO's Track One prioritized examination will allow you to get a final disposition within about twelve months. The USPTO offers Track



One for prioritized examination of your utility and plant patent applications. Track One gives your application special status with fewer requirements than the current accelerated examination program and without having to perform a pre-examination search.

Prioritized examination is available for a fee at the time of filing an original utility or plant application. A single request for prioritized examination may be granted for a Request for Continued Examination (RCE) in a plant or utility application.
