Students must also submit a PDF Screenshot of your academic summary from CalCentral, which will include all your enrollments for your law degree. You can find the summary by going to your "My Academics" page in CalCentral. Click on "View Academic Summary" on the right of your "Semesters" card to pull up the summary.

If you are in the remote + summer program or your second summer of the two-summer program, your application must be received no later than June 24 if you wish to receive the certificate during the summer. However, you can apply for the Executive Track Business Law Certificate at any time during that summer or after, and the certificate will be mailed to a permanent residence.

In the event classes will be conducted online during the Fall 2021 and Spring 2022 semesters, we will email the certificates and mail a hard copy when campus is back in full operation.
