DECLARATION OF KENNETH BRAKEBILL

I, Kenneth Brakebill, declare and state as follows:

1. I am an Assistant United States Attorney in the Northern District of California and counsel of record for Defendants in the above-captioned action.

2. I submit this declaration in support of the Stipulation and Joint Request to extend the initial case management conference.

3. Counsel for both parties were available for the initial case management conference previously scheduled on July 14, 2022.

4. The Clerk's notice resetting the initial case management conference to July 28, 2022, which also reset the deadline for the filing of the parties' joint initial case management conference to July 21, 2022, presented scheduling conflicts for counsel for both parties. Counsel for Plaintiffs is out of the country during the two weeks prior to the currently-scheduled case management conference, while counsel for Defendants is out of the office on the date of the conference.

4. The parties therefore propose to move the date of the initial case management conference from July 28, 2022 to August 25, 2022. The proposed date is the next date that both counsel are available for the Court's Thursday case management conference schedule.

5. There has been no other schedule change, or request to move dates, in this case.

6. While this date change pushes the initial case management conference back by four weeks, it will not delay progress in this case. The parties have been diligently working toward an agreement concerning search and production. The parties hope to be able to report on such an agreement by the time of the initial case management conference.
