Meet with the CDO to discuss your strategy and get support.




Cast a wide search net. Consider your skills, interests, and professional networks.



Put your **best foot forward**. Highlight your skills, commitment, and experience in your application materials.

Judicial Clerkships

Many levels and types of clerkships!

Timing

- Many judges will hire starting this spring/summer for clerkships to start in fall 2026
- Alaska state courts early 3L fall
- San Francisco and Los Angeles
 Superior Court around winter
 break of 3L



Government Opportunities

- Opportunities available through:
 - Government Honors Programs (federal and state level)
 - o Fall OCI
 - Presidential Management Fellows (PMF)
 - Government Fellowships (including local government!)
- Network with alums ask the CDO for potential connections.
- Join the CDO's PIPS Google Group.
- Use the Government Internship and Honors Arizona Handbook (Password: BlueandGold4ever)

Public Defender Offices

- Post-bar law clerk positions (time limited) vs. attorney positions
- Hire throughout Fall semester.
- Participate in Fall OCI and Equal Justice Works Career Fair.
- 3L students may want to consider Spring externship to gain more experience & contacts.
- Geographically flexible? Talk to the CDO!

Project-Based Fellowships

- Funded by an outside entity. You write the grant with support from your host org.
- Examples: Equal Justice Works, Skadden, Justice Catalyst, Soros Justice Fellowship, Berkeley Law Foundation, and Borchard Fellowship
- Join the CDO's PIPS Google Group. Talk with the CDO!

Highly competitive, but Berkeley Law grads have a strong track record of success!

Project-Based Fellowships: Process

Spring/ Summer [2L] Identify & secure a host organization based on your interests.

Summer [2L]

Design your project, with input from host organization.

Fall [3L]

Apply to funders.

1-7 months after applying

Application review period, followed by interviews and notification.

Organizational Fellowships

- Usually time-limited (1-2 years), but can result in permanent offers.
- Include nonprofit organizations, Plaintiff-side/private public interest firms, and academic.
- Usually announced throughout the Fall, with applications due as early as August through
 December.
- Examples:
 - Immigrant Justice Corps; ACLU Norcal; Inner City Law Center housing fellowships;
 NRDC (Nonprofit)
 - Georgetown Prettyman; Columbia Climate Change (Academic)
 - Goldstein Borgen Dardarian & Ho; Shute, Mihaly & Weinberger (Firms)

Staff Attorney Positions

- Some public interest organizations (especially in direct services) will consider 3Ls for entry-level staff attorney positions.
- Some organizations recruit in fall (to begin the following Fall).
 Others will consider from mid-spring through late summer.
- Usually funding/vacancy based.
- Examples: LSNC, HAC, EDC, Law Foundation of Silicon Valley, have all hired 3Ls in the past.

Plaintiff-side Firms

- Hire on as-needed basis for entry-level positions & through fellowships.
- Develop a direct application strategy.
- Networking is very important! Come to Plaintiff-side Career Fair at Berkeley Law on February 19.
- There are usually some entry-level post-grad positions available with employers participating in Berkeley Law's Fall OCI Program.

Bottom Line

There are many ways to land a PIPS job.

Timing of Job Search

- Hiring begins in the spring/summer for many <u>clerkships</u>.
- Hiring begins in the late summer/fall for government honors programs, many organization-based fellowships, Plaintiff-side firms, and most public defender offices.
- Some opportunities open up in the winter and spring as well.



Job Search Steps to Take Now

- Attend upcoming CDO programs to learn more about opportunities & application processes.
- Familiarize yourself with PIPS job search resources (b-Line, PSJD.org,
 LinkedIn, Idealist, Arizona Guide for government opportunities, etc.)
- NETWORK! The CDO can help to put you in touch with PIPS alums.
- Continue building your public interest credentials.

Job Search Steps to take over Summer & Fall

- Meet with a CDO counselor.
- Finalize your application materials. Send your resume and a cover letter to a CDO counselor for review.
- Review employers with early Fall deadlines. Apply!
- Participate in Berkeley Law's Fall OCI Program and the EJW
 Career Fair. Some organizations and agencies interview 3Ls
 through these programs.

Preview of Interview Programs in Summer & Fall

Fall OCI **Equal Justice Works (EJW) Career Fair** Apply in August, interviews Apply by September, happen in September interviews happen around (virtual) October, Includes "table talk" component. Public interest organizations, All-virtual, run by EJW government agencies, public defense offices, and (national org). small/mid-size law firm (including Plaintiff-side Public interest and firms). government agencies, including public defense offices.
