- Submit a complete Berkeley Law JD application for admission
- Include a 1-2 page statement addressing this prompt:

Knowing the challenges that can come with pursuing a public interest legal career, what drives you toward your goals, and how do you plan to make a meaningful impact with your legal degree?

#### **Deadline**

- December 15 for Regular Decision applicants
- November 15 for Binding Early Decision applicants

#### **Factors**

- Dedication to public interest or public service prior to law school
- Commitment to public interest work during 1L and 2L summers and post-graduation
- Demonstration of leadership and initiative
- Likelihood of making a lasting impact on Berkeley Law's community

## **Decisions**

- Typically made between February April
- Finalists may be asked to complete additional essays or interviews

- Full tuition scholarship (resident and non-resident) + fees & SHIP health insurance
- Community of other scholars, staff, faculty, alumni, and practitioners
- Opportunities for mentorship
